West Overton: Self-guided museum tour showing various industries spawned at this location. Also experience a guided tour of the Overhold Homestead and learn how people in the 19th celebrated Christmas. If visiting near the Christmas holidays, the mansion rooms will be adorned in period decorations. Learn about Christmas in southwestern Pennsylvania as far back as 1800, the lore of gift givers like Belsnickel and Santa Claus, and the origins of customs such as the Christmas tree. Take a class and learn how to make your own melt-and-pour bar of soap scented with traditional herbs. Makes a great gift!!

The Loucks Homestead in Scottdale: Tour this beautifully restored 5-story federal style farm house with spring house, summer kitchen, and ice house in back.



Connellsville Canteen: Hand hewn train model, Native American display, WWII displays. Step back in time to the 1940's and learn about the history of South Western Pennsylvania during WWII. Not only did the men go off to war, but the women also contributed to the war effort by opening a "Canteen" and feeding over 600,000 troops that passed through Connellsville
