

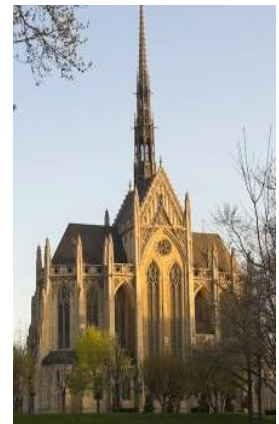
The **Pretty** **Gritty** and **Brawn** of **Pittsburgh**

Pretty in Pittsburgh (Makes a beautiful Christmas tour too!! Especially enjoy evening lights)

Pittsburgh's Skyline: USA Today ranked the nighttime view from Grandview Avenue as the second-most beautiful interior view in America, behind only Red Rock Country in Arizona. Indeed, the panoramic view of Pittsburgh from Mt. Washington is considered one of the best skyline views in the world. Take the **Duquesne Incline** for a special history lesson of workers traveling in and out of the city.



Heinz Memorial Chapel: Admire this stunning nondenominational chapel, known for its beautiful architecture and peaceful atmosphere.

Nationality Rooms at the University of Pittsburgh: Explore this unique collection of classrooms representing various cultures and ethnicities, located on the first few floors of the Iconic Cathedral of Learning on campus.

National Aviary: Discover a wide variety of birds from around the world at this vibrant zoo.

Carnegie Museums of Art and Natural History: Explore exhibits on natural history, dinosaurs, and more at this world-renowned museum.

Gritty in Pittsburgh

Strip District: This vibrant neighborhood is known for its fresh produce, specialty foods, and unique shops. It's a great place to wander and explore.

History of steel and coke that built the nation. Explore the **Rivers of Steel National Historic Landmark**, a complex of preserved industrial sites that tell the story of Pittsburgh's steelmaking heritage. Take a tour of the Carrie Furnace, a historic blast furnace that played a key role in Pittsburgh's industrial development. Learn about the coal and coke plants that processes the coal mined from the veins of coal in the ground nearby and turn them into elements to make steel. Have a **special immigrant lunch at the Pump House on the river** and learn about the babushkas and hard hats donned by the sturdy people who helped build the nation. *Combine this tour with a history tour in Fayette County and learn more about the coal mine operations and the lives and homes of workers and coal barons there.*

Visit the **U.S. Steel Tower**, a landmark skyscraper that once housed the headquarters of the United States Steel Corporation. Also see beautiful iconic downtown headquarters buildings for glass and many other corporations.
