- Johnstown Flood National Memorial, site of the South Fork Dam that failed sending a devastating flood into the city of Johnstown on May 31, 1889 taking the lives of more than 2200 people.
- Johnstown Flood Museum where you view an Academy Award winning film, *The Johnstown Flood*, an excellent depiction of the events of that day and those following. Many interesting exhibits throughout the museum that was once a Carnegie Library.
- Grandview Cemetery where you see nearly 800 graves of the unknown victims of the flood.
- Lunch at one of the area's fine restaurants.
- As time permits, the Johnstown Heritage Discovery Center with its Immigration History and the Iron and Steel Gallery.
