A Beautiful Trip to the Past

- Connellsville Canteen offers a look at the world during the WWII era. See exhibits of WWII memorabilia, photos and bios of local veterans who served in this war.
- See the Henry Clark RR display, a 25 X 50-foot layout of HO Scale trains, all scratch built.
- Colebrook Chocolates provides yummy samples and an opportunity for you to purchase fine chocolates made right here.
- Luncheon and a tour at Mount St. Macrina, a Uniontown Monastery for the Byzantine Catholic Order of Sisters of St. Basil. The retreat house, a stunning mansion once owned by J.V. Thompson, a leading figure in the coal and coke boom of the late 19th century provides a luncheon location as well as a tour of the beautiful mansion.
- A brief driving tour of the city of Uniontown points out Marshall Plaza, honoring George C. Marshall, author of the Marshall Plan at the conclusion of WWII.

- Yesterday's Today Antique Shop
- Historic Titlow Tavern OR Bistro with courtyard for an afternoon break at your leisure.
- Art Gallery where everyone makes a simple craft piece to take home AND browse many unique, one-of-a-kind pieces of art at exceptional prices.
