#### 2 DAY TOUR / Best dates Thanksgiving thru Mid-December

**Day 1:** Meet local guide at a location to be set when tour is booked. Depending on arrival time lunch can be arranged (on own or included) if needed.

- Guided candlelight tour of Compass Inn, restored stagecoach stop, circa 1799
- Shopping in the quaint village of Ligonier OR visit the Fred Rogers Exhibit at nearby St. Vincent College. Mr. Rogers was born and raised in Latrobe and this exhibit explains how he became the inspiring teacher of children and all-round wonderful person! Depending on your arrival time both of these stops may be included.
- Check in to Latrobe Springhill Suites Hotel OR Greensburg Hampton Inn.
- Dinner at a local restaurant.
- Following dinner depart for Overly Country Christmas, a guided driving tour through the lights display and time to stroll around the grounds... nativity scene, bonfire, Christmas Carols, gift shop, train display.  
Approx. 9:00 PM return to hotel. (D)



**Day 2:** Breakfast at hotel. 8:30 AM check out and depart with local guide.

- Greensburg Ramada Hotel presents the Annual Parade of Trees throughout the lobby and hallway. Local businesses decorate trees and you vote for your favorites by dropping a donation into that tree's "ballot" box.
- Browse at Craftique Collections, over 7000 square feet of shopping pleasure ~ handcrafted, retail items of all kinds and café where you are treated to a hot drink. Craftique is a great place to find that special gift this holiday season.
- View one of the world's finest model railroad displays, Henry Clark's 25 X 50 ft. layout is amazing! The Clark RR display is just a part of what you find in the Connellsville Canteen. Built to honor the men and women of the area who served in WWII and the local ladies who operated the Connellsville Canteen throughout the war, here you find countless photos, memorabilia and stories of hometown heroes.
- Next door to the Canteen is Appalachian Art Works featuring a wide variety of locally made artisan items.
- A stop at Colebrook Chocolates provides an opportunity to sample and purchase many delicious candies made right here.
- Next at the Cochran House, a classic Victorian home you are served a delicious home-cooked Christmas dinner featuring roast beef and ham loaf. Following this meal, you have time to stroll through the home to view the beautiful holiday decorations. Many guests describe the Cochran House as "the best Victorian home tour **ever!**" Musical entertainment adds to the festivities. NOTE: meal may be at a nearby church followed by house tour.
