

**TOWN AND COUNTRY ~
PITTSBURGH AND THE LAUREL HIGHLANDS
3-DAY PACKAGE**

Day 1: Near mid-day meet your local guide at a location to be determined. Lunch on own at area restaurant. This afternoon pay your respects at the Flight 93 National Memorial, Memorial Chapel and United 93 Monument as well as the Quecreek Mine Rescue site. All of these stops are very *country* and tell inspiring stories. The first two honor God and the amazing bravery of 40 heroes on 9/11/2001 and the third tells the story of the miracle of the rescue of nine miners trapped 240 feet beneath a farmer's field. You hear the story, see the site, touch the actual rescue capsule and broken drill bit along with many other exhibits on mining in general and the Quecreek Mine in particular. Dinner this evening at DiSalvo's Station, excellent dining in a restored train station. Following dinner you arrive at the Greensburg Ramada hotel for a good night's rest. (D)



Day 2: Breakfast at hotel. Meet a Pittsburgh guide as you arrive in *town*, the city of Pittsburgh! Highlights of Pittsburgh for today:

- Spectacular city view from the top of Mount Washington.
- Visit the University of Pittsburgh's Cathedral of Learning and tour some of the 26 Nationality Classrooms. Each room is designed and decorated to reflect the cultures that Pittsburgh immigrants brought from Europe, Asia, Africa and the Middle East.
- Tour Phipps Conservatory and Botanical Gardens, a 13-room Victorian glasshouse and gardens featuring tropical and desert plants, palms, orchids, bonsai and special exhibits.
- Lunch on own then a visit to the Frick Art Museum and Car/Carriage Collection and Clayton, the restored 19th century Victorian home of Henry Clay Frick.
- Top off this day with dinner at the Grand Concourse, the city's most elegant restaurant in a restored P & LE Train Station.



8:30 PM est. return to hotel. (B/D)

Day 3: Breakfast, check out and depart with local guide. Today you are back in the *country*. This morning you tour Kentuck Knob, a remarkable Frank Lloyd Wright designed home-located just minutes from world-famous Fallingwater. The House on Kentuck Knob is an easy one to tour as a mini-bus delivers you to the front door and the home is all on one level. Many who tour this home say they could move right in!! ***To exchange Fallingwater for Kentuck Knob ~ add \$5 pp.***


