### FROM THE TITANIC TO LINCOLN HIGHWAY AND MORE

Approx. 7 hour day from arrival at first stop.

Meeting local guide at a location TBD, approx. 10:00-10:30 AM.

- First stop ~ Antiochian Village where you meet with this conference center's chef for a demo and making your own dessert for today's luncheon...eclairs!
- Tour the Antiochian Heritage Museum which presents the artistic, cultural and spiritual heritage of the Near East, Orthodox Christianity, and its roots in Antioch (Syria) and the Holy Land. Exhibits include the richly inlaid wood furniture of Damascus, colorful hand-embroidered clothing, antique religious icons, and early Bibles in English and Arabic. An interactive touchscreen display explores the life of Saint Raphael who served as Bishop of Brooklyn during the early 1900s.



- Titanic Exhibit ~ see artifacts and learn about local people and their ties to the ship.
- Lunch inspired by actual passenger menus on board the great ship including your eclairs!



- St Vincent College ~ Working Gristmill since 1854 ~ history ~ purchase flours made here and breads baked from gristmill flours



- Latrobe Art Center ~ ART ~ make your own! Each tour member creates a set of 4 one-of-a-kind four inch square coasters/hot pads. Yummy snacks too!

- Lincoln Highway Heritage Corridor ~ see and hear history of the iconic Route 30 that runs all the way from New York City to San Francisco. Great nostalgic stop!
